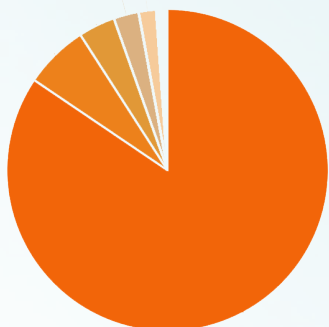




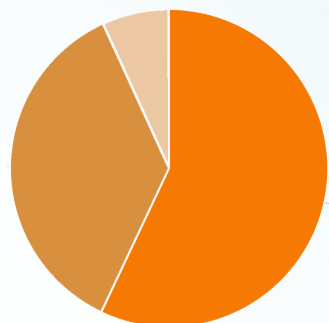
Right around the corner from San Diego!

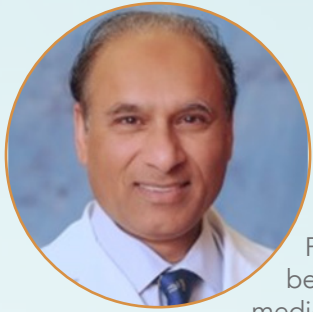

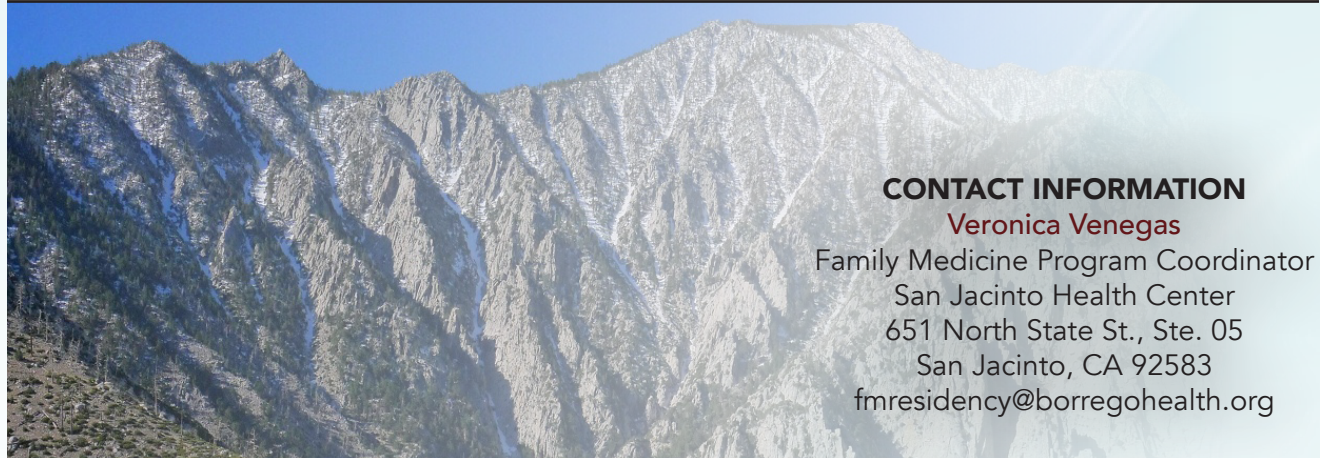
We have partnered with Hemet Valley Medical Center in San Jacinto to give residents the exposure needed to become successful physicians.
